An Act to amend the Highways Act, 1926-1969.

[Assented to 4th December, 1969.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Highways Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1969".
- (2) The Highways Act, 1926-1969, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Highways Act, 1926-1969".
- (3) The Highways Act, 1926-1969, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 30b— Provision for compensation.

3. Section 30b of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "any court having jurisdiction in personal actions to the amount claimed" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "the Land and Valuation Court constituted under the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1969".
