An Act to amend the Highways Act, 1926.

[Assented to 26 October 1989]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Highways Act Amendment Act, 1989.
- (2) The Highways Act, 1926, is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on the day that the Road Traffic Act Amendment Act (No. 3), 1989, comes into operation.

Application of Highways Fund

- 3. Section 32 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subparagraph (i) of subsection (1) (1) and substituting the following subparagraph:
 - (i) allocating, at regular intervals, for the purposes of road safety services provided otherwise than by the Police Department, an amount equal to one-sixth of the fees received by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles during those intervals for the issue of driver's licences in respect of which the full licence fee has been paid, together with—
 - (A) if fees are separately charged for the registration of the prime mover and semi-trailer portions of an articulated motor vehicle—one-hundredth of the fees received by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles during those intervals for the registration of commercial motor vehicles (other than prime movers and trailers) that have an unladen mass of more than 5 tonnes and for the registration of prime movers;

(B) if fees are not so charged—one-hundredth of the fees received by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles during those intervals for the registration of commercial motor vehicles that have an unladen mass of more than 5 tonnes;.
