An Act to enable the Corporation of the Municipality of Henley and Grange to join in the scheme of Municipal Electric Tramways authorised by the Municipal Tramways Trust Act, 1906.

[Assented to, November 8th, 1917.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the "Henley and Grange Electric Tramways Act, 1917." Short title.

2. This Act is incorporated with the Municipal Tramways Trust Act, 1906 (hereinafter called "the principal Act"), and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation with principal Act.

3. On and from the passing of this Act—

(a) the Corporation of the Municipality of Henley and Grange shall be a Suburban Corporation, and shall be subject to the same liabilities and have the same rights as if originally included as a Suburban Corporation in the principal Act; and the definition of "Suburban Corporation" in section 3 of the principal Act shall be read as including the said Corporation;

(b) for the purposes of subdivision (b) of subsection (1) of section 50 of the principal Act, the assessed annual value of ratable property in the Municipality of Henley and Grange shall be taken as Twenty-three Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-three Pounds; and

(c) the

Henley and Grange Electric Tramways Act.—1917.

(c) the definition of "Town Clerk" in section 3 of the principal Act shall be read as including the Town Clerk, or the person for the time being performing the duties of the Town Clerk, of the Municipality of Henley and Grange.

Representation of
Suburban Corpora-
tions.

4. The present members of the Trust appointed by the Corporations of the Cities of Port Adelaide and Unley and the Towns of Kensington and Norwood, St. Peters, Hindmarsh, and Thebarton shall, subject to the provisions of the principal Act, continue to hold office for the balance of the periods for which they were appointed respectively, but the Corporation of the Municipality of Henley and Grange shall be entitled to take part in every appointment of a member of the Trust by the Suburban Corporations after the passing of this Act.
