An Act to amend the Housing Improvement Act,
1940-1971.

[Assented to 21st October, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Housing Improvement Act Amendment Act, 1971".

(2) The Housing Improvement Act, 1940-1971, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Housing Improvement Act, 1940-1971".

(3) The Housing Improvement Act, 1940-1971, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 16 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting in paragraph (b) of subsection (5) after the word "factory" firstly occurring the passage "and any addition to a factory";

(b) by inserting in paragraph (b) of subsection (5) after the word "factory" secondly occurring the passage "or addition to a factory";

(c) by inserting in subsection (5) immediately after paragraph (b) the following passage:—

and

(c) on the recommendation of the Industries Development Committee, purchase any factory and any land used in connection with that factory.;

- (d) by striking out from subsection (6) the passage "or factory" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "factory, or addition to a factory";
- and
- (e) by striking out from subsection (6) the passage "together with any land occupied" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "or any factory purchased pursuant to subsection (5) of this section together with any land used in connection".
