An Act to amend the Hairdressers Registration Act, 1939-1978.

[Assented to 19 March 1981]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Hairdressers Registration Act Short titles. Amendment Act, 1981".
- (2) The Hairdressers Registration Act, 1939-1978, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Hairdressers Registration Act, 1939-1981".
- 2. Section 35 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after its present Amendment of a. 35 contents (now to be designated as subsection (1)) the following subsections:

Power to make regulations.

- (2) Fees prescribed by a regulation made under this section may vary according to factors specified in the regulation.
- (3) The first regulation made under subsection (1) (h) after the commencement of the Hairdressers Registration Act Amendment Act, 1981, shall be expressed to be retrospective to the thirty-first day of January, 1981.
