An Act to amend the Hairdressers Registration Act, 1939-1978.

[Assented to 19 March 1981]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Hairdressers Registration Act Amendment Act, 1981". Short titles.

(2) The Hairdressers Registration Act, 1939-1978, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Hairdressers Registration Act, 1939-1981".

2. Section 35 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after its present contents (now to be designated as subsection (1)) the following subsections: Amendment of s. 35—
Power to make regulations.

(2) Fees prescribed by a regulation made under this section may vary according to factors specified in the regulation.

(3) The first regulation made under subsection (1) (h) after the commencement of the Hairdressers Registration Act Amendment Act, 1981, shall be expressed to be retrospective to the thirty-first day of January, 1981.
