An Act to amend the Hairdressers Registration Act,
1939-1946.

[Assented to 13th December, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the " Hairdressers Registration Act Amendment Act, 1951 ".

(2) The Hairdressers Registration Act, 1939-1946, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the " Hairdressers Registration Act, 1939-1951 ".

(3) The Hairdressers Registration Act, 1939-1946, is hereinafter referred to as " the principal Act ".

Fees.

2. Section 21 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the words " one pound one shilling " in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words " one pound eleven shillings and sixpence " ;

(b) by striking out the words " one shilling " in paragraph (b) of subsection (2) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words " eleven shillings and six pence " ;

(c) by striking out the words " one shilling " in the fourth line of subsection (4) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words " eleven shillings and six pence ".

3. Section 29 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting after the word " letters " in the third line of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) thereof the words " or whether under the name of a company, association or institute or under any like name or title " ;
- (b) by inserting after the word " letters " in the third line of paragraph (b) of subsection (1) thereof the words " or whether under the name of a company, association or institute or under any like name or title " .
