## No. 44.

*An Act to further amend "The Insolvent Act, 1860."*

[Assented to, 27th October, 1876.]

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to further amend "The Insolvent Act, 1860"—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows: Preamble.

1. During the temporary absence of the Commissioner from illness or on leave of absence, any one or more of Her Majesty's Judges of the Supreme Court of the said Province shall have and may exercise all the power of the Court and Commissioner: Provided that notice of such illness or leave of absence be inserted in the *Government Gazette*. In absence of Commissioner, Judge of Supreme Court may act.

2. Except so far as the same is inconsistent with or altered by this Act, "The Insolvent Act, 1860," and "The Insolvent Amendment Act, 1867," and the "Insolvent Further Amendment Act, 1870," shall be incorporated and read herewith as forming one Act; and nothing herein contained shall affect the operation of Section 7 of "The Insolvent Act, 1860;" and in the said incorporated Acts the words "Commissioner of Insolvency" shall be read and construed so as to include any Judge or Judges of the Supreme Court so acting as aforesaid. Incorporation of Act with the Insolvent Acts of 1860, 1867, and 1870.

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
