## No. 1709.

An Act to alter the title of the Commissioner of Insolvency and to amend the Insolvent Acts, 1886 to 1915, accordingly.

*[Assented to, December 24th, 1925.]*

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the " Insolvent Act Amendment Act, 1925 " Short title.

(2) The Insolvent Acts, 1886 to 1915, and this Act may be cited together as the " Insolvent Acts, 1886 to 1925 ".

2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in section 1 of this Act, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. The Commissioner of Insolvency shall hereafter be known by the title of Judge in Insolvency, and the Insolvent Acts, 1886 to 1915, shall be read and construed as if the term Judge in Insolvency were substituted for the term Commissioner of Insolvency or Commissioner wherever either of the latter terms is used. Alteration of title of Commissioner of Insolvency.

4. Nothing in this Act shall affect any power of a Special Magistrate when acting as Commissioner of Insolvency of any Local Court of Insolvency. Saving of powers of Special Magistrates.
