An Act to amend the Immigration Act, 1923, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, December 14th, 1927.]

E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia. with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Immigration Act Short titles. Amendment Act, 1927.
- (2) The Immigration Act, 1923 (hereinafter called "the principal No. 1599 of 1923. Act"), and this Act may be cited together as the "Immigration Acts, 1923 and 1927."
- 2. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by inserting therein Amendment of after the definition of "agreement" the following definition:-

principal Act, s. 3. Definition of Board.

- "Board" means the Board of Management of the State Bank of South Australia established by the State Bank Act, 1925.
- 3. Section 10 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the Amendment of passage "and any moneys paid or credited to the said fund under principal Act, s. 10. section 17 of this Act" in the fourth and fifth lines thereof.
- 4. Subsections (2) and (3) of section 13 of the principal Act Repeal of certain and section 17 of the principal Act are hereby repealed.

provisions of principal Act.

5. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended—

Amendment of principal Act, s. 15.

- (a) by striking out the words "or other person" in the first line of subsection (2) thereof; and
- (b) by striking out subsection (3) thereof. 1810

6. Section

Immigration Act Amendment Act.—1927.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 16.

- 6. Section 16 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out the word "or" in the second line of paragraph (c) thereof; and
 - (b) by striking out paragraph (d) thereof.

Repeal of principal Act, s. 20. Abolition of Immigrants' Assistance Board. 7. Section 20 of the principal Act is repealed.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 21.

8. Section 21 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end of paragraph (a) thereof the following passage:

Applications for loans by immigrants apprenticed under previous Act. "or who has, whether before or after the passing of this Act, completed a term of apprenticeship in farming or any other prescribed pursuit under section 4 of the Immigration Act Amendment Act, 1913, to the satisfaction of the Minister".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 23. Applications to be recommended by Director of Immigration.

9. Section 23 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "application" in the first line the words "and if the Director of Immigration recommends that such application be granted".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 23. Instalments in repayment of advances.

- 10. Subsection (2) of section 23 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out the words "at the prescribed times and in instalments of the prescribed amount" in the second and third lines thereof, and inserting in lieu thereof the words "at such times and in such instalments as are determined by the Board"; and
 - (b) by adding at the end thereof the following proviso:—

 Provided further that the time determined by the Board for the repayment of any advance shall not exceed twelve years.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 25.

- 11. Subsection (1) of section 25 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out paragraph (b) thereof; and
 - (b) by striking out the words "and the amount of the instalments by which such advance is to be repaid" in paragraph (h) thereof.

Amendment of principal Act.
The Schedule.

12. The Schedule to the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "Commissioner of Crown Lands and" therein, and inserting in lieu thereof the words "Minister of".

Validation of certain forms of agreement.

13. Any person who, before the passing of the principal Act, signed a statement in either of the forms in the Schedule to this Act, or in a form to the like effect, shall be deemed for all purposes to have signed a statement in the form in the Schedule to the Immigration Act Amendment Act, 1913.
