An Act to amend the Irrigation Act, 1930-1978.

[Assented to 19 March 1981]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Irrigation Act Amendment Act, 1981".

(2) The Irrigation Act, 1930-1978, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Irrigation Act, 1930-1981".

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Repeat of Part VI and substitution of new Part. 3. Part VI of the principal Act is repealed and the following Part is substituted:

PART VI

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO LESSEES

81. (1) The Minister may, upon such terms and conditions as he determines, grant financial assistance to a lessee—

- (a) for the purpose of making improvements to land leased under this Act by the lessee;
- (b) for the purpose of discharging a mortgage over the land;

or

(c) for the purpose of enabling the lessee to purchase implements, stock, seeds, plants, trees or other things required for farming the land.

(2) Assistance under this section may consist of a non-repayable grant or a loan.

Financial assistance to lessees. (3) Moneys required for the purposes of this section shall be paid out of moneys provided by Parliament for those purposes.
