An Act to amend the Impounding Act, 1920-1974.

[Assented to 10th April, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Impounding Act Amendment Act, Short titles. 1975".
- (2) The Impounding Act, 1920-1974, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Impounding Act, 1920-1975".
- 2. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from sub-Amendment of principal Act, and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "five pounds" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage 1.7 section (2) the passage "five pounds" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "forty dollars".

(3) In respect of the impounding of cattle, some of which are of the descriptions mentioned in paragraph (1) hereof, and some of which are of the descriptions mentioned in paragraph (2) hereof—

The above fees are payable by each owner in respect of the cattle owned by him impounded at any one time.

No fee shall be chargeable for a suckling animal under the age of six months running with its mother.
