An Act to amend the Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1923-1952.

[Assented to 11th November, 1954.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Industrial and Provident Societies Act Amendment Act, 1954".
- (2) The Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1923-1952, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1923-1954".
- (3) The Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1923-1952, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 65—Regulations.

- 3. Section 65 of the principal Act is amended by inserting at the end of subsection (1) thereof the following subsection:—
 - (1a) In the exercise of the power contained in subsection (1) of this section to make regulations for or with respect to fees, and without limiting the generality thereof, the Governor may make regulations—
 - (a) prescribing an increased fee to be paid where a return required to be sent to the Registrar within a time specified by this Act is not so sent, but is sent within a time specified in the regulations following the expiration of the time specified by this Act:

- (b) prescribing a further increased fee to be paid where a return is sent to the Registrar after the expiration of both those times:
- (c) empowering the Registrar if he is satisfied that just cause exists for so doing to reduce any such increased fee payable by any person to an amount not less than the original fee.
