An Act to amend the Industries Development Act,
1941-1951.

[Assented to 27th November, 1958.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Industries Development Act Amendment Act, 1958". Short titles.

(2) The Industries Development Act, 1941-1951, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Industries Development Act, 1941-1958".

(3) The Industries Development Act, 1941-1951, is herein after referred to as "the principal Act".

2. The following heading and section are enacted and inserted in the principal Act after section 24 thereof :— Enactment of s. 25 of the principal Act—

Provision of Factories in Country Areas.

25. (1) The South Australian Housing Trust, with the consent of the Governor and upon the recommendation of the Committee, may build factory premises upon any land of the said Trust which is situated outside the metropolitan area. Provision of factories in country areas by South Australian Housing Trust.

(2) The said Trust may, for such term and upon such conditions as the said Trust thinks fit, let any such premises together with any land occupied therewith or may sell the same upon such conditions as the said Trust thinks fit.

(3) In this section "metropolitan area" means the municipalities of Adelaide, Brighton, Burnside, Campbelltown, Enfield, Glenelg, Henley and Grange, Hindmarsh, Kensington and Norwood, Marion, Mitcham, Payneham, Port Adelaide, Prospect, St. Peters, Thebarton, Unley, Walkerville, West Torrens and Woodville and the Garden Suburb of Colonel Light Gardens.

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
