An Act to amend the Inter-State Destitute Persons Relief Act, 1910-1943.

[Assented to 1st December, 1955.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Inter-State Destitute Persons Relief Act Amendment Act, 1955".

(2) The Inter-State Destitute Persons Relief Act, 1910-1943, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Inter-State Destitute Persons Relief Act, 1910-1955".

(2) The Inter-State Destitute Persons Relief Act, 1910-1943, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

**Amendment of principal Act, s. 4—
Interpretation.**

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by inserting after the word "maintenance" in the eighth line of the definition of "order" therein the words "registered or";

(b) by striking out the word "mandate" in the fourth and tenth lines of the definition of "State" therein, and inserting in its place in each case the words "trusteeship agreement, trust, mandate, or other like arrangement";

(c) by inserting at the end thereof the following subsection (the preceding portion of section 4 being read as subsection (1) thereof):

(2) References in this Act to orders registered under the provisions of any Act reciprocal to the Imperial Act intituled the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Act, 1920, shall be deemed to refer to orders registered under any such Act whether before or after the commencement of the Inter-State Destitute Persons Relief Act Amendment Act, 1955.

4. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting after the word “made” in the first line of subparagraph v. of paragraph (a) therein the word “registered”;
- (b) by striking out the word “confirmed” in the twenty-fourth line thereof.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 6—
Summons for relief issued in another State may be served in this State.

5. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting after the word “made” in the first line of subparagraph v. of paragraph (a) therein the word “registered”;
- (b) by inserting after the word “made” in the twenty-fifth line thereof the word “registered”.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 7—
Summons for relief against defaulter in another State.

6. Section 14 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word “made” in the sixth line of paragraph i. of subsection (1) thereof the word “registered”.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 14—
Application for making order for relief enforceable in this State.

7. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word “made” in the fifth line thereof the word “registered”.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 15—
To be endorsed if defaulter resident in this State.

8. Section 16 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word “made” in the fifth line of subsection (1) thereof the word “registered”.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 16—
Collector to serve copy of endorsed order.

9. Section 19 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting after the word “been” in the fourth line thereof the words “registered or”;

Amendment of principal Act, s. 19—
Collector to forward orders for relief for service in other States.

(b) by inserting after the words "elsewhere is" in the seventh line thereof the words "registered or";

(c) by inserting after the word "been" in the twelfth line thereof the words "registered or";

(d) by inserting after the word "made" in the sixth line of paragraph 1. therein the words "or registered".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 20—
Affidavit or certificate of collector sufficient proof of payment.

10. Section 20 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "made" in the second line of subsection (2) thereof the word "registered".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 27a—
Application of Act to orders confirmed under Acts reciprocal to Imperial Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Act, 1920.

11. Section 27a of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "order" in the second line thereof the words "registered or".

Amendment of principal Act—
First Schedule.

12. The first schedule to the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "confirmed" in the fifth line of paragraph 1 therein and inserting in its place the words "registered (or confirmed)".

Amendment of principal Act—
Second Schedule.

13. The second schedule to the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "confirmed" in the fourth line of paragraph 2 therein and inserting in its place the words "registered (or confirmed)".
