**An Act to amend the Inflammable Liquids Act, 1961-1974.**

*[Assented to 28th October, 1976]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

**Short titles.**

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Inflammable Liquids Act Amendment Act, 1976".

(2) The inflammable Liquids Act, 1961-1974, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Inflammable Liquids Act, 1961-1976".

Interpretation.**

2. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from the definition of "inflammable liquid" the passage "one hundred and fifty degrees Fahrenheit" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "sixty-one degrees Celsius".
