GEORGII V REGIS. A.D. 1928.

No. 1862.

An Act to amend the Inflammable Oils Acts, 1908 and 1909, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, November 1st, 1928.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Inflammable Oils Act Short titlos. Amendment Act, 1928".

(2) The Inflammable Oils Acts, 1908 and 1909, and this Act may be cited together as the "Inflammable Oils Acts, 1908 to 1928".

(3) The Inflammable Oils Act, 1908, is hereinafter referred to as No. 958 of 1908. "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in Incorporation. section 1 of this Act, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act.

3. Section 10 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after Amendment of principal Act, s.

- (d) In quantities not exceeding one thousand gallons on any inflammable oils. land which is more than five acres in area and is used for agricultural, horticultural, floricultural, or pastoral pursuits, in any case where the inflammable oil is used in connection with the said pursuits and is not kept for the purpose of retail sale.
- In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
