*An Act to Increase the Salaries of the Judges of the Supreme Court, and of certain Officers of the Civil Service, of the Province of South Australia.*

[Assented to, 18th December, 1873.]

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to increase the salaries of the Judges Preamble.  
of the Supreme Court of the Province of South Australia, and of certain officers of the Civil Service of the Province of South Australia, mentioned in "The Constitution Act" and the "Third Judge and District Courts Act"—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. From and after the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, there shall be payable and paid out of the General Revenue of the said Province, to the First Judge (or Chief Justice), Second Judge, Third Judge, Crown Solicitor and Public Prosecutor, Under Secretary, and Auditor-General respectively, the salaries mentioned in and set opposite to the respective titles of the said Judges and Civil Servants in the Schedule hereto, in lieu and instead of the salaries by law now payable to the said Judges and Civil Servants respectively.

Increasing salaries of Judges and certain Civil Servants.

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty I hereby assent to this Act.
