An Act to amend the Livestock Act 1997.

[Assented to 18 March 1999]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Livestock (Commencement) Amendment Act 1999.
- (2) The Livestock Act 1997 is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Amendment of s. 2—Commencement

- 2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after its present contents (now to be designated as subsection (1)) the following subsection:
 - (2) Section 7(5) of the Acts Interpretation Act 1915 does not apply to Part 6, Part 7 or Schedule 2.

Amendment of Sched. 2-Repeal and Transitional Provisions

3. Schedule 2 of the principal Act is amended by striking out clause 3.
