**An Act to amend the Licensing Act, 1967.**

*[Assented to 2 May 1985]*

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Licensing Act Amendment Act, 1985".

(2) The Licensing Act, 1967, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the twenty-first day of February, 1985.

Amendment of s. 25—  
Distiller's storekeeper's licence.

3. Section 25 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (4a) the following subsection:

(4b) An authorization shall not be granted under subsection (4) (a) except in pursuance of an application made to the court before the twenty-first day of February, 1985.

Amendment of s. 33a—  
Tourist facility licence.

4. Section 33a of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsection:

(2a) Where an application for the grant or removal of a tourist facility licence is made on or after the twenty-first day of February, 1985—

(a) the court, before granting the application, shall take into account the probable effect of the grant or removal of the licence on the trade conducted from other licensed premises in the relevant locality;

and

- (b) the application shall not be granted unless the court is satisfied that the premises to which the application relates are, or will prove to be, a substantial tourist attraction and that the licensing of the premises is necessary to provide adequately for the needs of those attracted to the premises.
