An Act to amend the Libraries Act, 1982.

[Assented to 27 September 1984]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Libraries Act Amendment Act, 1984".

(2) The Libraries Act, 1982, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection:

(2) The membership of the Board must include—

- (a) one member who is a member or officer of a council, nominated by the Local Government Association of South Australia;
- (b) one member with experience in local government (who may, but need not, be a member or officer of a council), nominated by the Local Government Association of South Australia;
- (c) one other member with experience in local government (who may, but need not, be a member or officer of a council).

3. Section 10 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph (d) of subsection (3) and substituting the following paragraph:

Terms and  
conditions  
of memberships.

(d) being a member nominated under section 9 (2) (a), he ceases to be a member or officer of a council;
