An Act to amend the Lifts and Cranes Act, 1985.

[Assented to 1 December 1988]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Lifts and Cranes Act Amendment Act, 1988.

(2) The Lifts and Cranes Act, 1985, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Registration of cranes, hoists and lifts

2. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (13) "shall be deemed to have been registered under this section for the balance of the term for which it was registered under the repealed Act" and substituting "will be taken to be registered under this Act".

Section 17	Delete "\$5 000" and substitute "Division 5 fine".
Section 19(1)	Delete "and liable to a penalty not exceeding twenty thousan dollars" and substitute "Penalty: Division 3 fine".
Section 25 (1) (m)	Delete paragraph (m) and substitute the following paragraph: (m) prescribe fines not exceeding a division 5 fine for contravention of the regulations.
