## No. 1382.

An Act to amend the Lottery and Gaming Act, 1917,  
with respect to Licences authorising the Use of  
the Totalizator.

[Assented to, November 20th, 1919.]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia,  
with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as  
follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the “ Lottery and Gaming Act Amendment Act, 1919.” Short title.
- (2) The Lottery and Gaming Act, 1917 (hereinafter referred to as “ the principal Act ”), and this Act may be cited together as the “ Lottery and Gaming Acts, 1917 and 1919.” No. 1285 of 1917.
2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act, and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation with principal Act.
3. (1) Subsection (3) of section 15 of the principal Act is amended so as to read as follows :— Amendment of ibid., s. 15 (3)—
  - (3) Every licence so issued shall be in force from the day specified in the licence until the succeeding thirty-first day of December (both days inclusive), and shall entitle the club therein mentioned to use the totalizator upon the racecourse and upon the days specified in such licence, or upon such other day or days in place of any of the days so specified as the Chief Secretary may from time to time, in writing upon such licence, approve. Use of totalizator licence may be postponed to other days approved by Chief Secretary.

(2) Subsection (4) of section 15 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the word “during” in the second line thereof the words “in respect of”.

4. Section 25 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following provision:—

“If any licence is granted after the publication of such particulars as aforesaid, the Commissioner of Police shall, as soon as possible after the granting of such licence, cause to be published in the *Government Gazette* the same particulars with respect to the licence so granted.”

Second Schedule.

5. The Second Schedule to the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the words “for one year only” in the second line of clause 3 thereof; and

(b) by striking out the words “the day of” in the fourteenth line of the Form of Licence contained in clause 3 thereof and substituting in lieu thereof the passage “or upon such other day or days in place of any of the said days as the Chief Secretary may from time to time in writing upon this licence approve. This licence shall be in force from the            day of            19   , to the succeeding thirty-first day of December (both days inclusive).”
