## No. 26 of 1972

An Act to amend the Lottery and Gaming Act, 1936-1971.

[Assented to 6th April, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Lottery and Gaming Act Amendment Act, 1972".

(2) The Lottery and Gaming Act, 1936-1971, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Lottery and Gaming Act, 1936-1972".

(3) The Lottery and Gaming Act, 1936-1971, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Repeal of s. 63 of principal Act.

3. Section 63 of the principal Act is repealed.
