## No. 1630.

An Act to amend the Loans for Fencing Act, 1919.

[Assented to, December 18th, 1924.]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Loans for Fencing Act Short titles.  
Amendment Act, 1924."

(2) The Loans for Fencing Act, 1919 (hereinafter referred to as No. 1403 of 1919.  
"the principal Act"), and this Act may be cited together as the  
"Loans for Fencing Acts, 1919 and 1924."

2. Subsection (1) of section 6 of the principal Act, is amended— Amendment of  
principal Act, s. 6—  
Requisites of  
petition.
- (a) by inserting after the word "amount" in the twelfth line of paragraph (e) thereof the passage ", including interest,";
  - (b) by striking out the word "One" in the penultimate line of paragraph (e) thereof and substituting therefor the word "Two"; and
  - (c) by striking out the word "One" in the last line of paragraph (e) thereof and substituting therefor the word "Two".
