An Act to amend the Local Government Act, 1934.

[Assented to 22 December 1983]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Local Government Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1983". Short title.

(2) The Local Government Act, 1934, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 157 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from paragraph (d) of subsection (1) the word "remove" and substituting the word "dismiss";

(b) by striking out paragraph (e) of subsection (1);

and

(c) by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection:

(1aaa) Suspension of an officer under subsection (1) (d) does not affect his right to remuneration in respect of the period of suspension.

Amendment of s. 157—
Appointment, removal and salaries of officers.

3. The following section is inserted immediately before section 163a of the principal Act:

163aa. As from the commencement of the Local Government Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1983, this Part shall apply only to the Town Clerk of The Corporation of the City of Adelaide.

Insertion of new s. 163aa.

Part to apply only to the Town Clerk of the City of Adelaide.

4. The following section is inserted immediately before section 163ja of the principal Act: Insertion of new s. 163jaa.

163jaa. As from the commencement of the Local Government Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1983, this Part shall apply only to officers employed by The Corporation of the City of Adelaide. Part to apply only to officers of the City of Adelaide.
