## No. 16 of 1969

An Act to amend the Local Government Act,  
1934-1967.

[Assented to 6th March, 1969.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

**Short titles.**

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Local Government Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1969".

(2) The Local Government Act, 1934-1967, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Local Government Act, 1934-1969".

(3) The Local Government Act, 1934-1967, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 299 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "Director of the Local Government Department" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Commissioner of Highways";

and

(b) by striking out from subsection (3) the word "Director" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "Commissioner".

3. Section 300a of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "Director of the Local Government Department" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Commissioner of Highways".
