An Act to amend the Local Government Act 1934.

[Assented to 27 March 1997]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Local Government (City of Adelaide Elections) Amendment Act 1997*.

(2) The *Local Government Act 1934* is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Amendment of s. 43—The principal member of council

2. Section 43 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (3) "(not exceeding two years)" and substituting (not extending beyond the conclusion of the next general election)";

(b) by striking out from subsection (5) "(not exceeding two years)" and substituting "(not extending beyond the conclusion of the next general election)".

Amendment of s. 94—Date of elections

3. Section 94 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection:

(1a) The Governor may, by proclamation, determine that a general election will be held for the City of Adelaide on a Saturday falling on or after 2 May 1998 but not later than 5 September 1998.
