## An Act to amend the Local Government Act 1934.

[Assented to 27 March 1997]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

## Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Local Government (City of Adelaide Elections) Amendment Act 1997.
  - (2) The Local Government Act 1934 is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

## Amendment of s. 43—The principal member of council

- 2. Section 43 of the principal Act is amended—
- (a) by striking out from subsection (3) "(not exceeding two years)" and substituting (not extending beyond the conclusion of the next general election)";
- (b) by striking out from subsection (5) "(not exceeding two years)" and substituting "(not extending beyond the conclusion of the next general election)".

#### Amendment of s. 94—Date of elections

- 3. Section 94 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (1) the following subsection:
  - (1a) The Governor may, by proclamation, determine that a general election will be held for the City of Adelaide on a Saturday falling on or after 2 May 1998 but not later than 5 September 1998.
