An Act to amend the Local Government Act 1934.

[Assented to 8 August 1996]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Local Government (Ward Quotas) Amendment Act 1996.
- (2) The Local Government Act 1934 is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Amendment of s. 11—Formation, alteration or abolition of wards

- 2. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (6) the following subsections:
 - (7) Subsections (5) and (6) do not apply to a proposal under Division X.
 - (8) However, if a proposal under Division X that relates to the formation or alteration of wards does not comply with subsections (5) and (6) and the relevant proposal proceeds (either in its original or an amended form) then, unless otherwise determined by proclamation, the relevant council (or each relevant council) must conduct (and complete) a review of its composition and wards under Division XI so as to enable appropriate changes in the composition and wards of the council to take effect on or before the date of the second general election of the council after the proposal takes effect or, if an earlier date is fixed by proclamation, on or before that date.
