An Act to amend the Legal Practitioners Act 1981.

[Assented to 18 April 1991]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

## Short title

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Legal Practitioners (Miscellaneous) Amendment Act 1991*.
- (2) The *Legal Practitioners Act 1981* is referred to in this Act as “the principal Act”.

## Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

## Right of audience

3. Section 51 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph (c) of subsection (1) and substituting the following paragraphs:

- (c) a legal practitioner acting on the instructions of the Corporate Affairs Commission;
- (ca) a legal practitioner acting on the instructions of the Australian Securities Commission;

## Quorum, etc.

4. Section 70 of the principal Act is amended by inserting in subsection (6) “except with the approval of the Attorney-General” after “Society”.
