An Act to amend the Legal Practitioners Act, 1936.

[Assented to 24th November, 1938.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Legal Practitioners short utiles. Act Amendment Act, 1938".
- (2) The Legal Practitioners Act, 1936, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Legal Practitioners Act, 1936-1938".
- (3) The Legal Practitioners Act, 1936, is in this Act called 2804, 1936. "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the Legal Practitioners Act, Incorporation. 1936, and this Act and that Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the Enactment of s. 60a of principal Act principal Act after section 60 thereof:—

- 60a. (1) The Treasurer shall pay to the Society such Society to part of all the money paid before the thirty-first day of maintain a law library. January, nineteen hundred and forty-four, to the Master by legal practitioners pursuant to section 13 of this Act as is in excess of a sum calculated at the rate of five pounds for each legal practitioner paying any money under that section, and this section shall be a sufficient authority for every such payment without any further appropriation.
- (2) The Society shall expend all money so paid to it on the establishment and maintenance of a library for the use of legal practitioners and any other persons permitted by the Society to use the library.

(3) The secretary of the Society shall upon the request of the Auditor-General produce to him any books and accounts, and furnish him with any information which he requires for the purpose of satisfying himself that any money paid to the Society under this section has been expended by the Society as required by this section.
