## An Act to amend the Legal Practitioners Act, 1936-1943.

[Assented to 22nd December, 1948.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Legal Practitioners short titles. Act Amendment Act, 1948".
- (2) The Legal Practitioners Act, 1936-1943, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Legal Practitioners Act, 1936-1948 ''.
- (3) The Legal Practitioners Act, 1936-1943, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. The following section is enacted and inserted in the Enactment of incipal Act after section 11 thereof:—

  Enactment of principal Act principal Act after section 11 thereof:—

11a. (1) If any person who is not a legal practitioner relation or whose name has been struck off the roll of legal practition. Falsely pretending to be a solicitor. titioners and not restored thereto, pretends to be a barrister. solicitor, attorney or proctor, or a person qualified or recognized by law as qualified, to act as a barrister, solicitor, attorney or proctor, he shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds.

(2) In this section "pretend" means to pretend, represent, imply, or hold out, whether directly or indirectly, and whether by words, conduct or other means whatsoever.
