An Act to amend the Legal Practitioners Act, 1936-1977.

[Assented to 1st March, 1979]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Legal Practitioners Act Amendment Act, 1979".
- (2) The Legal Practitioners Act, 1936-1977, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Legal Practitioners Act, 1936-1979".

Commencement.

principal Act, s. 69— Legal practitioners employed by Crown may practise and appear before any court.

Amendment of

- 3. Section 69 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out from paragraph (a) of subsection (1) the passage "who is employed by the Crown and"; and

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

- (b) by striking out paragraph (b) of subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:—
 - (b) the Commissioner for Corporate Affairs or a legal practitioner acting on the instructions of the Corporate Affairs Commission,.
