## No. 29 of 1956.

An Act to extend the Land Settlement Act, 1944-1955, and for purposes incidental thereto.

[Assented to 15th November, 1956.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Land Settlement Act Short titles. Extension Act, 1956".
- (2) The Land Settlement Act, 1944-1955, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. (1) The principal Act shall remain in force until the thirty- Extension of first day of December, ninteen hundred and fifty-seven.

(2) Subject to section 6 of the principal Act, every member of the Committee holding office at the time of the passing of this Act and any person appointed to a casual vacancy occurring on the Committee before the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, shall hold office until the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.
