An Act to amend the Land Settlement Act, 1944-1965.

[Assented to 10th August, 1967.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Land Settlement Act Amendment Act, 1967".
- (2) The Land Settlement Act, 1944-1965, as amended by this Act may be cited as the "Land Settlement Act, 1944-1967".
- (3) The Land Settlement Act, 1944-1965, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 5— Term of office of members.

3. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven" wherever occurring therein and inserting in lieu thereof, in each case, the words "One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 4—

Power to acquire land in South-East.

4. Subsection (4) of section 27a of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "nineteen" therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "twenty-one".
