An Act to amend the Land Tax Act 1936.

[Assented to 2 December 1999]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Land Tax (Intensive Agistment) Amendment Act 1999.
- (2) The Land Tax Act 1936 is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Commencement

2. This Act will be taken to have come into operation at midnight on 30 June 1999.

Amendment of s. 2-Interpretation

- 3. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended—
- (a) by inserting in the definition of "business of primary production" in subsection (1) "and including the intensive agistment of declared livestock" after "or other aquatic organisms";
- (b) by inserting after the definition of "company" in subsection (1) the following definition:

"declared livestock" means—

- (a) cattle, sheep, pigs or poultry; or
- (b) any other kind of animal prescribed by the regulations for the purposes of this definition;
