GEORGII V REGIS. A.D. 1919.

No. 1375.

An Act to amend the Loans to Producers Act, 1917, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, November 20th, 1919.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Loans to Producers Short titles. Act Amendment Act, 1919."

(2) The Loans to Producers Act, 1917 (hereinafter called "the No. 1312 of 1917. principal Act"), and this Act may be cited together as the "Loans to Producers Acts, 1917 and 1919."

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act, and that Act Incorporation with principal Act. and this Act shall be read as one Act.

3. The definition of "Landholder" contained in section 2 of the Amendment of principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following passage: --- "not being a miscellaneous lease."

4. Subsection (2) of section 3 of the principal Act is amended by Amendment of striking out the word "Ten" in the third line thereof and inserting "Thirty-five" in lieu thereof.

5. Section 8 of the principal Act is repealed.
