An Act to amend the Loans to Producers Act, 1927.

[Assented to, December 23rd, 1927.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Loans to Producers Act Amendment Act, 1927". Short titles.
- (2) The Loans to Producers Act, 1927 (which is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act") and this Act may be cited together as the "Loans to Producers Acts, 1927". No. 1802 of 1927.
2. Subsection (4) of section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "or fallowing such land" at the end thereof. Amendment of principal Act, s. 5.
3. The principal Act is amended by inserting therein after section 5 the following section:— New section 5A—
 - 5A. (1) The Bank may make loans out of the Loans to Producers Fund to any landholder for the purpose of enabling him to fallow his land or any portion thereof. Loans for fallowing
 - (2) Notwithstanding any Act or law to the contrary, a bill of sale given for the purposes of securing any loan made under this section shall, although given before the existence of any growing crop, be as valid and effectual and have the like force and effect as if it had been given on a growing crop.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
