An Act to amend the Loans to Producers Act, 1927.

[Assented to, December 23rd, 1927.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Loans to Producers Act Short titles. Amendment Act, 1927".
- (2) The Loans to Producers Act, 1927 (which is hereinafter referred No. 1802 of 1927. to as "the principal Act") and this Act may be cited together as the "Loans to Producers Acts, 1927".
- 2. Subsection (4) of section 5 of the principal Act is amended by Amendment of striking out the words "or fallowing such land" at the end thereof.
- 3. The principal Act is amended by inserting therein after section New section 54—5 the following section:—
 - 5A. (1) The Bank may make loans out of the Loans to Pro-Loans for fallowing ducers Fund to any landholder for the purpose of enabling him to fallow his land or any portion thereof.
 - (2) Notwithstanding any Act or law to the contrary, a bill of sale given for the purposes of securing any loan made under this section shall, although given before the existence of any growing crop, be as valid and effectual and have the like force and effect as if it had been given on a growing crop.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
