**An Act to amend the Loans to Producers Act,
1927-1946.**

[Assented to 11th October, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Loans to Producers Act Amendment Act, 1951".

(2) The Loans to Producers Act, 1927-1946, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Loans to Producers Act, 1927-1951".

(3) The Loans to Producers Act, 1927-1946, is hereinafter called the "principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section is enacted in its place :—

Financial
provision.

4. The money required for the purposes of this Act shall be paid out of money voted by Parliament for those purposes.

4. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by striking out in the third and fourth lines of subsection (1) the words "out of the Loans to Producers Fund".

5. Section 5a of the principal Act is amended by striking out in the first and second lines thereof the words "out of the Loans to Producers Fund".

6. Section 5b of the principal Act is amended by striking out in the first and second lines thereof the words "out of the Loans to Producers Fund".

7. Section 13 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "the Loans to Producers Fund" at the end of subsection (2) thereof and inserting in their place the words "money provided by Parliament for the purposes of this Act."
