No. 18 of 1941.**An Act to amend the Marriage Act, 1936.**

[Assented to 30th October, 1941.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the " Marriage Act Amendment Act, 1941 ".

(2) The Marriage Act, 1936, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the " Marriage Act, 1936-1941 ".

(3) The Marriage Act, 1936, is hereinafter referred to as " the principal Act ".

2. Section 26 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end of subsection (1) thereof the words " and the signature of any parent or guardian giving such consent shall be witnessed by the principal registrar or the deputy registrar or by a district registrar, officiating minister, officiating registrar, justice, or commissioner for taking affidavits in the Supreme Court."

3. The form No. 3 in the third schedule to the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the words " who is under the age of twenty-one years " in the said form and by inserting in lieu thereof the passage " who was born aton the.....day of.....19 ";

(b) by inserting after the line " Dated this day of
19 ", the following passage :—

Signed before me this day of 19 .
.....Officiating Minister.
.....Officiating Registrar.
.....District Registrar.
.....Principal Registrar.
.....Deputy Registrar.
.....Justice of the Peace.
.....Commissioner for
 taking affidavits
 in the Supreme
 Court.
