An Act to amend the Margarine Act, 1939-1941.

[Assented to 11th November, 1948.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles,

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Margarine Act Amendment Act, 1948".
- (2) The Margarine Act, 1939-1941, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Margarine Act, 1939-1948".
- (3) The Margarine Act, 1939-1941, is hereinafter called the "principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of s. 20 of principal Act— Amount of margarine to be manufactured.

- 3. Section 20 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsections (3) and (3a) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsections:—
  - (3) The Minister shall not by declarations made under this section permit to be manufactured in any calendar year a greater aggregate quantity of table margarine than three hundred and twelve tons.
  - (3a) The declaration made under this section on the nineteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and forty-seven shall be read as if the quantities of margarine therein specified were increased by one-fifth.
