An Act to amend the Mining Act, 1971-1973.

[Assented to 6th March, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Mining Act Amendment Act, 1974-1975". Short titles.

(2) The Mining Act, 1971-1973, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Mining Act, 1971-1975".

2. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "sole" in subsection (1) the passage "and any reference in any Act, regulation, rule, by-law, agreement, or in any document or other instrument, whether directly or indirectly, to The Minister of Mines shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be read and construed and be deemed to be and, since the commencement of this Act, to have been a reference to the Minister".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 11—  
The Minister and the Director to be corporations sole.
