**An Act to amend the Money-lenders Act, 1940.**

*[Assented to 27th October, 1960.]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

**Short title.**

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Money-lenders Act Amendment Act, 1960".

(2) The Money-lenders Act, 1940, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Money-lenders Act, 1940-1960".

(3) The Money-lenders Act, 1940, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

**Incorporation.**

**2.** This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act may be read as one Act.

**Amendment of principal Act, s. 7.**

**3.** Subsection (2) of section 7 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "company" first occurring in paragraph (c) thereof the words "which consists of less than fifty members".

**Amendment of principal Act, s. 10.**

**4.** Subsection (1) of section 10 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "address" first occurring in paragraph (c) thereof the words "within the area of the jurisdiction of the local court to which an application is made".
