An Act to amend the Margarine Act, 1939-1974.

[Assented to 10th April, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Margarine Act Amendment Act, Short titles. 1975".
- (2) The Margarine Act, 1939-1974, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Margarine Act, 1939-1975".
 - 2. This Act shall come into operation on the first day of April, 1975.

3. Section 20 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from Amendment of principal Act, the passage "one thousand seven hundred and s. 20 paragraph (b) of subsection (8) the passage "one thousand seven hundred and fifty-three tonnes" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "two thousand five hundred and forty and one-half tonnes".

Control of the amount of table margarine that may be manufactured.
