An Act to amend the Marine Act, 1936-1973.

[Assented to 10th April, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Marine Act Amendment Act, 1975".
- (2) The Marine Act, 1936-1973, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Marine Act, 1936-1975".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 14—  
Regulations.

2. Section 14 of the principal Act is amended by inserting immediately after paragraph v the following paragraph:—
  - vi. For prescribing any matter or thing relating to the operation of a vessel or vessels of a class:.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 26d—  
Determination by Committee.

3. Section 26d of the principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by inserting in subsection (9) immediately after the passage "in relation to" the following passage:—

  - (b) by inserting in subsection (9) immediately after the word "sea" the following word and paragraph:—
 

and
  - (b) any prescribed vessel or vessel of a prescribed class of vessels.
