An Act to amend the Metropolitan Area (Woodville, Henley and Grange) Drainage Act, 1964.

[Assented to 13th April, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Metropolitan Area (Woodville, Henley and Grange) Drainage Act Amendment Act, 1972". Short titles.

(2) The Metropolitan Area (Woodville, Henley and Grange) Drainage Act, 1964, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Metropolitan Area (Woodville, Henley and Grange) Drainage Act, 1964-1972".

(3) The Metropolitan Area (Woodville, Henley and Grange) Drainage Act, 1964, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by inserting in the definition of "works" after the passage "of the report" the passage "and includes works substituted for the works referred to in the report by arrangement between the councils or with the agreement of the councils".

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (5) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—

(5) When the sum of seven hundred and seventy-two thousand six hundred dollars has been expended on the works, the Treasurer shall publish in the *Gazette* a statement certified by the Auditor-General certifying that that sum has been expended and that amount shall be the total cost for the purposes of subsection (4) of this section.
