An Act to amend the Masters and Servants Act, 1863.

[Assented to, 21st December, 1877.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend the Laws relating to Masters Preamble.
and Servants—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of
the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province,
in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as “The Masters and Servants Amend- Short title.
ment Act, 1877.”

2. Any person against whom any information shall be laid under Evidence.
the said Masters and Servants Act, 1863, and the husband or wife
of any such person, shall be competent witnesses, and may give
evidence on the hearing of the information.
