An Act to amend the "Marine Board and Navigation Act, 1881."

[Assented to, August 2nd, 1893.]

DE it Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

Section 400 of the "Marine Board and Navigation Act, 1881," Repeal of section 400 is hereby repealed, and from and after the coming into operation of of Act No. 237 of this Act china and after the coming into operation of 1881. this Act ships entering, remaining in, or leaving any port in the ships entering ports
